

## Mary Ann Becker Memorial/Polish American Heritage Association of Berks County POLONIA PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP

For the 2026-2027 academic year, one (1) \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student who is a Berks County resident and who can provide evidence that he/she is of Polish descent.

First year college "non-renewable" scholarship is available to high school seniors pursuing their studies in an accredited post-secondary educational institution in either a two or four-year program.

## Criteria for award include:

- HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR RESIDING IN BERKS COUNTY
- OFFICIAL ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT INCLUDING GPA TO VERIFY AT LEAST A 3.0 (B) AVERAGE OR EQUIVALENT AT TIME OF APPLICATION
- PROOF OF POLISH DESCENT (Use copies of documents such as birth certificates, passports, naturalization
  papers and other official documents to trace your lineage to the ancestor who was born in Poland.
  Highlight relevant names and arrange in chronological order. Suggestions: Try Ancestry.com or the Reading
  Family History Center, 3344 Reading Crest Drive, Reading by appointment)
- COMPLETION OF ENTIRE APPLICATION INCLUDING ALL REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS
- STUDENTS PERSONAL PROFILE ESSAY WHICH INCLUDES ACCOMPLISHMENTS, ACTIVITIES IN AND OUT OF SCHOOL, AND FUTURE GOALS, INCLUDING HOW YOU CELEBRATE YOUR POLISH HERITAGE
- SUBMISSION OF A PROJECT BASED ON POLISH HISTORY, CULTURE AND /OR TRADITIONS. STUDENTS ARE
  ENCOURAGED TO EXPLORE THEIR POLISH HERITAGE AND "THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX." THE PROJECT WILL BE
  AT THE STUDENT'S CHOICE BUT MUST BE INCLUSIVE OF ALL MATERIALS, MUST BE SELF SUFFICIENT AND BE
  IN ITS' ENTIRETY WHEN DELIVERED TO THE PAHABC CULTURAL CENTER FOR DISPLAY. PROJECT WILL BE
  JUDGED ON CONTENT, NEATNESS, ACCURACY AND AUTHENTICITY
- WRITTEN NARRATIVE WHY YOU CHOSE THE SUBJECT OF YOUR PROJECT
- STUDENT AWARDEE AND/OR THEIR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MUST BE PRESENT TO ACCEPT THE AWARD AT THE POLISH AMERICAN BOARD OF EDUCATION LUNCHEON ON APRIL 12, 2026
- ONE VISIT TO THE POLISH AMERICAN CULTURAL CENTER BY THE STUDENT AWARDEE AND ONE VOLUNTEER SUNDAY BY STUDENT AWARDEE AND/OR PARENT(S) WILL BE EXPECTED

**DEADLINE:** The project must be received it its' entirety, including all required documents, in the PAHABC Cultural Center at the GoggleWorks, 201 Washington Street, Room 509, Reading, PA 19601 by Sunday, March 15, 2026. No project will be accepted after that date. **Announcement of this award will be made by the end of March, 2026. The scholarship money will be forwarded to the student upon receipt of tuition payment for the Fall semester.**
